ACTIONS:

To achieve the above commitments, HHIT will:

- 1. Never compromise on safety, security, health, and environmental issues in exchange for profit or work efficiency;
- 2. The Board of Director will be responsible for safety, security, health, and environmental issues in business operations;
- 3. Managers and supervisors will ensure effective management while maintaining awareness that the proper handling of safety, security, health, and environmental matters is everyone's responsibility;
- 4. Focus on preventing accidents before they occur by proactively assessing and mitigating risks, prioritizing the use of the most effective risk control measures;
- 5. Establish a non-blame culture, never accepting negligence or willfully ignoring safety, security, health, and environmental regulations;
- 6. Comply with state regulations regarding safety, security, health, and environmental protection, as well as HHIT's own standards;
- Plan and set objectives for continuous improvement and periodically assess progress;
- 8. Encourage everyone to actively participate in safety, security, health and environmental activities;
- 9. Create effective communication for reporting, providing, and sharing information related to safety, security, health, and environmental matters across all levels of the Company, including contractors and stakeholders;
- 10. Listen to and consider employees' feedback on issues related to safety, security, health and the environment;

- 14. Allocate necessary resources to manage risks related to safety, security, health, and the environment;
- 15. Integrate safety performance evaluation into employees' regular performance reviews;
- 16. Promote and support the establishment of safety, security, health, and environmental management systems that align with this policy for contractors working at HHIT;
- 17. Efforts will be made to encourage the local community and other ports to participate in safety, security, health, and environmental activities;
- 18. Periodically review and revise this policy as necessary;
